

Johnson County 4-H Shooting Sports Shotgun Qualifier 2024

10:00 a.m., Powder Creek Shooting Park

(The bridge at 83rd St. and K-7 is under construction and closed. If you are coming from the South, you can exit off of 83rd St. If you are coming from the North, you will need to get off on E. Shawnee Mission parkway, to Monticello Rd South to the shooting park.)

Johnson County 4-H Shooting Sports will be hosting a State Qualifier trap and skeet shotgun match. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from 4-H age 10-18.

NOTE: the minimum age to participate at the State Match is 10 years old before Jan. 1, 2024

Registration form and fees are due by 5pm, August 16, 2024. Late registrations only accepted to fill flights. Fees are \$20 per shooter per discipline. No refunds. We will only accept registration from one person per county. Check-in will begin at 9:30 a.m. for the first flight. Each county needs to verify their shooters information when checking in for correct age. This is a qualifying match only, no awards.

Trap: Course of fire will be 50 clays at 16 yards. The qualifying score is 35 out of 50 targets. We will follow current ATA rules and 2024 Kansas State Match rules.

ONLY NEW SHELLS WILL BE ALLOWED, NO RELOADS! No larger than 12 ga. maximum shot size of 7 1/2 lead shot and a maximum shot charge of 1 1/8 oz (or depending on range rules).

Skeet: The course of fire will be 50 clays. The qualifying score is 30 out of 50. We will follow the current N SSA and 2024 Kansas State Match rules.

A shooter can qualify for State in trap, skeet or both. If a shooter qualifies in either trap or skeet, they can shoot sporting clays at the state match.

The grand aggregate of trap, skeet and sporting clays at the State match will determine ranking for the National match selection.

Shooters must provide their own shotgun and ammunition. Our range regulations require that ammunition not exceed 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ inch, 3 dram, 1 1/8 oz. shot 7 $\frac{1}{2}$, 8 or 9 shot. All shotguns will be approved by the Range Officer. **No barrels resting on toes, foot, or pointed at any part of the body. Eye and Ear protection required for anyone past the ready line.**
