AIR PISTOL

Air Pistol: Qualifying Course of Fire: Shoot 40 shots at 10 meters (at paper targets.) Rules will follow the current NRA-USAS rulebook. **To qualify for state in Air Pistol, the minimum individual score is 280 and the shooter must be at least 10 years old by 01-01-26.** Individual awards in Air Pistol will be given to the top 3 individual shooters in the Junior and Senior age divisions.

AIR RIFLE (Limit 40 shooters)

Air Rifle: Qualifying Course of Fire: Shoot 20 bull shots in each of the 3 positions. Rules will follow the current CMP National Standard 3-posi on Air Rifle rulebook. **To qualify for state in Air Rifle, the minimum individual score is 450 and the shooter must be at least 9 years old by 01-01-26.** Individual awards in Air Rifle will be given to the top 3 individual shooters in each age division.
Age groups will be determined after registrations are submitted.

BB GUN (Limit 60 shooters)

Qualifying Course of Fire: Shoot 10 bull shots in each of the 4 positions. Rules will follow the Daisy Match Program and NRA BB Gun rulebook. **To qualify for State in BB Gun, the minimum individual score is 335 and the shooter must be at least 9 years old by 01-01-26.** Individual awards in BB Gun will be given to the top 3 individual shooters in each age division. **8-year old's are welcome to participate.**
Age groups will be determined after registrations are submitted.
