



## Flint Hills Jr. Shooters

4-H SHOOTING SPORTS MATCH (State Qualifier) – BB Gun, Air Rifle, Air Pistol

**January 31, 2026** Alma, KS @ Wabaunsee High School

The Flint Hills Jr. Shooters will be hosting a match for BB Gun, Air Rifle & Air Pistol. This match is a state qualifier. State 4-H rules for Spring 2026 matches will be followed in addition to any rules stated below for individual disciplines. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from 4-H age 8 -18 in Air Pistol & Air Rifle. Ages 8-15 for BB.

NOTE: the minimum age to participate at the State Match is 9 years old before Jan. 1, 2026.

**Registration form and fees are due by January 19, 2026.** Late registrations only accepted to fill relays. Fees are \$15 per shooter per discipline. We will only accept registration from one person per county and this person will be notified of relay times. Each county must have at least 1 designated person to review targets after they have been scored. Registration begins at 7:00. - **Each county needs to verify their shooter's information when checking in for the correct age and discipline. We will be using Orion to pick team members. IF YOUR SHOOTERS ARE NOT SIGNED OFF ON BY A COACH OR COUNTY COORDINATOR BEFORE THE MATCH BEGINS, CHANGES WILL NOT BE MADE AT A LATER TIME IN THE DAY.**

**BB Gun:** Shooters will shoot 10 bull shots in each of the 4 positions. Rules will follow the current NRA BBGun rulebook and Daisy Match Guidelines. Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in each division. Age groups will be decided after registration numbers are submitted. Team awards will be given to the top 3 teams overall. Orion will be choosing teams. To qualify for the State Match in BB gun, the minimum individual score is 335 out of a possible 400.

**Air Rifle:** Shooters will shoot 20 bull shots in each of the 3 positions. Rules will follow the current CMP National Standard 3-position Air Rifle rulebook. Course of fire will follow the current ISSF format: Kneeling, Prone, and Standing. Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in each division. Age groups will be decided after registration numbers are submitted. Team awards will be given to the top 3 teams overall. Orion will be choosing teams. To qualify for the State Match in air rifle, the minimum individual score is 450 out of a possible 600.

**Air Pistol:** Shooters will shoot 40 shots at two targets with four bulls (five shots per bull) in two segments. Rules will follow the current NRA-USAS Progressive Air Pistol rulebook. Juniors 13 and under will shoot one or two handed unsupported. Seniors age 14 -18 will shoot one handed unsupported. Individual awards will be given to the top three shooters in each age division. Team awards will be given to the top three teams overall, as determined by highest aggregate scores of registered participating counties. To qualify for the State Match in air pistol, the minimum individual score is 280 out of a possible 400.
